FAITH SHARING

The first reading today describes how the Holy Spirit helped the Deacon Philip to preach powerfully and convert the Samaritans in large numbers. It also explains how the baptized Samaritans received a fresh anointing of the Holy Spirit through the imposition of hands by the apostles Peter and John. The litany contains many of the titles used formally and informally for the Virgin Mary, and would often be recited as a call and response chant in a group setting.

In our Parish we recite the litany in English after each Sunday Mass during month of May and we sing it in Polish on each Wednesday of May at 7:00 PM.


