FAITH SHARING

Today's readings explain why Christians are expected to be holy and how we are meant to become holy people. The first and second readings give us reasons why we should be holy and the Gospel describes the methods of becoming holy people prescribed for us by Jesus.



Jesus tells us that what makes Christians different is the grace with which they treat others, offering them loving kindness and mercy, even if they don't deserve this treatment. We are commanded to love our enemies as Jesus loves us, with agápe love,

not because our enemies deserve our love, but because Jesus loves them so much that he died for them as he did for us.

Today's Scripture readings really challenge us to become holy as our God is holy by loving, forgiving and blessing others as our Holy God does.

I would like to send my greetings from Poland to all my Parishioners and Friends. I miss you all! Please pray for my safe trip home. See you soon! Fr. M.


