Mt. Sinai. Pentecost (Whitsunday), with Christmas and Easter, ranks among the great feasts of Christianity. On Christmas we celebrate the birthday of Christ in His Physical Body. 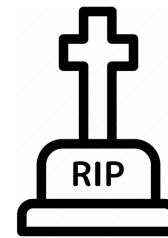

Today is again a big celebration – Pentecost. This day we call a Birthday of the Church and so indeed it is. Happy Birthday to all of us, because we are the Church.

ST. VALENTINE'S CEMETERY BURIAL RULES

One more time we would like to remind you some cemetery rules. Certificate of burial rights is what it says "Certificate of burial rights" not an ownership of the plot. It gives you only the right for burial. It is not transferable to anybody else and has no monetary value.



Quoting *St. Valentine's Cemetery Rules and Regulations, Andalusia, PA, July 9, 1989:*

"#6. Any member owning a burial privilege in an unoccupied grave who has failed to meet the financial and spiritual obligations to remain a member in good standing at a Polish National Catholic Church for a period of two consecutive years will lose and forfeit the burial privileges granted and the grave will revert to St. Valentine's Parish free and clear of any claims from any party.

#7. No Interment in any grave shall be allowed unless all fees in effect at the time of interment have been paid in advance to the Pastor or Parish Committee of St. Valentine's Parish."

According to St. Valentine's Cemetery Rules and Regulations due to unpaid parish dues for more than two years, family loses the rights to burial. However, if the living relatives would like to renew parish membership and pay 10 years back parish dues, St. Valentine's Parish can waive the cemetery rules and return the plots to the family. For active and inactive members of PNCC and relatives of PNCC members current yearly dues are \$225.00 per person.

If the person is non-member of PNCC and not related to the member of PNCC, the dues and fees are doubled.

ST. ADALBERT PARISH SUMMER FESTIVAL

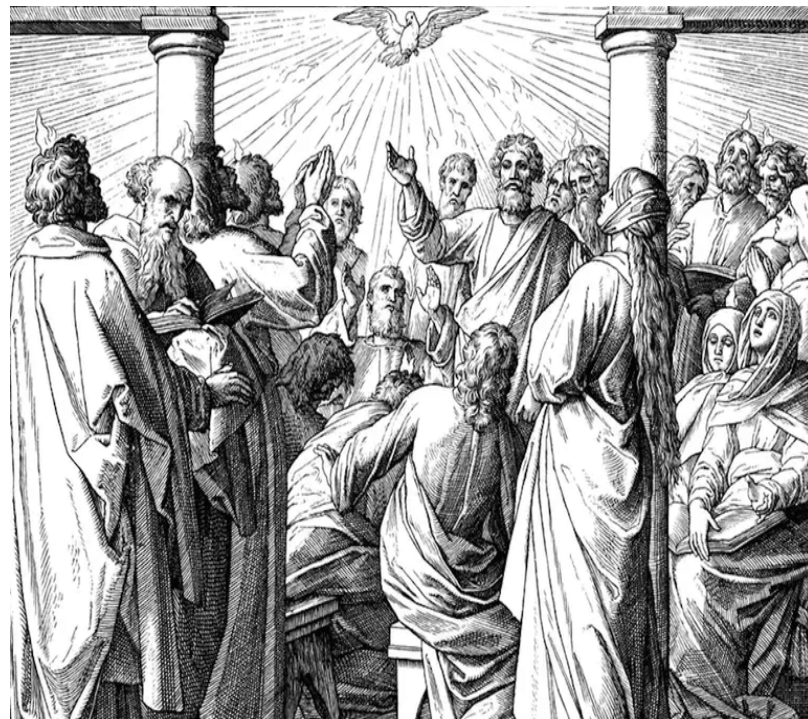
