FAITH SHARING

Corpus Christi is the celebration of the abiding presence of the loving God as *Emmanuel* – God-with-us – in order to give collective thanks to our Lord living

with us in the Eucharist. The feast gives us an occasion to learn more about the importance and value of his “Real Presence,” so that we may appreciate the Sacrament better and receive maximum benefit from receiving Jesus in Holy Communion.

In the first reading, Moses instructs the Israelites to “*remember and not forget*” the miraculous provision of food in the manna given to them to save their lives in the desert.



In the second reading, Paul reminds the Corinthians that the Bread they share is the real Body of Christ, which makes their community also the Body of the risen Christ.

In today's Gospel passage, Jesus identifies himself as “*the Living Bread that came down from Heaven*,” thus linking himself with the manna in the wilderness, while assuring his disciples that, unlike those who ate manna, “*One who eats this Bread will live forever.*”
