

Easter is the greatest and the most important feast in the Church. The Resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian Faith. It is the greatest of the miracles, for it proves that Jesus is God.

Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection.

Easter is a feast which gives us hope and encouragement in this world of pain, sorrows, and tears. It reminds us that life is worth

living.

We are to be Resurrection people: Easter, the feast of the Resurrection, gives us the joyful message that we are a "Resurrection people."
