The 13th Synod of the Central Diocese will be held on **Friday, November 12th and Saturday, November 13th, 2021** at All Saints Parish in Rome, NY. Our parish is not entitled to send a lay delegate to this Synod. St. Valentine's will be represented by Fr. Mariusz only.

In accordance with the Constitution of the Polish National Catholic Church Article VII Part C Section 2 Composition & 3 Lay Delegates, each parish is entitled to send their pastor or administrator, and to elect one delegate who is in good standing with the Diocese per 50 members, and is in good standing on the Parish roll.
