All of the Apostles were put to death in horrible ways. We are to follow the example of the Apostles and talk to people about our faith. Like them we will face many terrible things, maybe not being put to death, but maybe just as worse as those we talk to may not stay our friends. We may be laughed at, mocked, or even left out of those groups of friends. That is alright Jesus will remain our friend; He will love us for doing this.

As I have said before, talk to people you know who may not have a church, or are low on faith. Be like the many who through the centuries spoke for Jesus, and accept come what may. Think of your family members who helped organize our church and what they endured.
